

## Fees for writing immigration reports and services

An immigration evaluation includes an assessment and a report, each having separate fees. The Assessment fees are the same as the fees that are charged for therapies as seen in the consent to treat. Most cases require an initial session of 1½ hours with one to three more sessions. On occasion, more sessions are necessary. The fee for the report is \$1050 if only one person is being evaluated in the report. If more than one is evaluated for the report the fee for the report is \$1150. See consent to treat for a more detailed explanation of fees.

All fees are required at the time of service. The fee for the report is required before the report will be released. The fee for the report is required if services are cancelled after having began services with us as we begin working on your report after the first session, continuing to make changes as we meet together.

We will provide the attorney on the case with the original report and you with a copy or the original directly to you, depending on your preference. The report will be written in English.

The assessment will assist in helping the therapist make a recommendation in a report for what is believed to be in the best interest of the client (and their family if applicable) in regards to immigration. While the assessment can be considered a useful tool to make a stronger case, this assessment does not guarantee the client's satisfaction with the outcome of the case or/and the report.
